

FLETCHER CREEK IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

**BYLAW NO. 2**  
**CAPITAL EXPENDITURE CHARGE BYLAW**

A bylaw to fix a charge for Capital Expenditure on certain lands within the District.

WHEREAS the owners of land within the boundaries of the District have paid a capital contribution of \$2500.00 per connection to construct the works of the Improvement District; and

WHEREAS it is considered necessary and equitable that any new connections be required to pay a similar capital contribution to augment system capacity to ensure an adequate water supply;

The Trustees of Fletcher Creek Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. In addition to any charges payable under the provisions of any connection charge bylaw in force at the time of an application for a connection to the works of the District, each and every applicant for such a connection shall pay a capital expenditure charge of \$4000.00 per connection payable to the District upon application for a connection.
2. All sums of money collected under this bylaw shall be deposited in a special Trust Account, separate from all other funds of the District, and deposits in such special Trust Account plus all interest or earnings thereon shall be disbursed only by a Resolution of the Trustees of the District which has been given the written approval of the Inspector or Deputy Inspector of Municipalities.
3. This bylaw may be cited as the "Capital Expenditure Charge Bylaw".
