1. Approval of Agenda

The FCID application to IHA for a work permit has been denied as per correspondence dated Sept 20, 2019. There may also need to be Ministry of Transport approval to cross Twin Bays Road. K. Mathers volunteered to compile information from the files on this application and to prepare a possible position statement for the FCID on this issue for possible presentation to IHA.

4.3 Secretary/Treasurer

Board members identified an urgent need for the services of a Secretary/Treasurer to conduct the routine administrative work of the Board. M. Wanke volunteered to investigate the availability of a position description and to contact S. Hewat regarding her role with the FCID.

4.4 Maintenance

S. Scott stated that Tucker the Plumber indicated he was willing to continue his role in maintenance of the FCID water system.
