	<ul> <li>a) Secretary/Treasurer Position. MOTION to verify emailed approval to contract D Butt of Kenadon Electronics Ltd. M Wanke/ S Scott. Carried.</li> </ul>
	b) System Flush. R Cunliffe and S Scott will document the procedure to carry out a system flush. This documentation will be kept in a water-proof sleeve at the shack. The flush is a two-person job and care must be taken to ensure that the tank is not drained. Some suggestion of two-way radios was made. A simple litmus test for chlorine residue after flushing the system was discussed and will be looked into. Action: R Cunliffe and S Scott will look into obtainingtwo-way radios and litmus test kits.

5	<ul> <li>Financial Reports. Reports for Dec. 2019 not available yet. Deferred to March meeting.</li> <li>a) 2020 operating budget. Decision to allocate money within operating budget to the siting of a water treatment facility. A 0% increase will be usedfor the next draft budget, to be discussed at the March Board meeting.</li> <li>b) 2020 Tax Assessment This requires a bylaw, two readings, &amp; registration with Municipal Affairs before enactment. Action: D Butt will look into the details.</li> <li>c) Wlosek Connection. Confirmed with R Wlosek that he will receive the service connection now that the McLaren boundary adjustment is finalized. He will be charged \$4,000 for the connection as per Bylaw #2.R Wlosek left the meeting at this point.</li> </ul>
6	Water System and Maintenance The leaking standpipe is being monitored and is not getting any worse. It will continue to be monitored by S Scott and R Cunliffe until the spring.  Decision that the Board will no longer charge for turning the water service on or off. Action: D Butt to look into whether a bylaw change is needed.
